Joining your class on a Mac – the “Link Method”

1. Copy and paste the OmniJoin Meeting **link** to the web browser’s address bar.

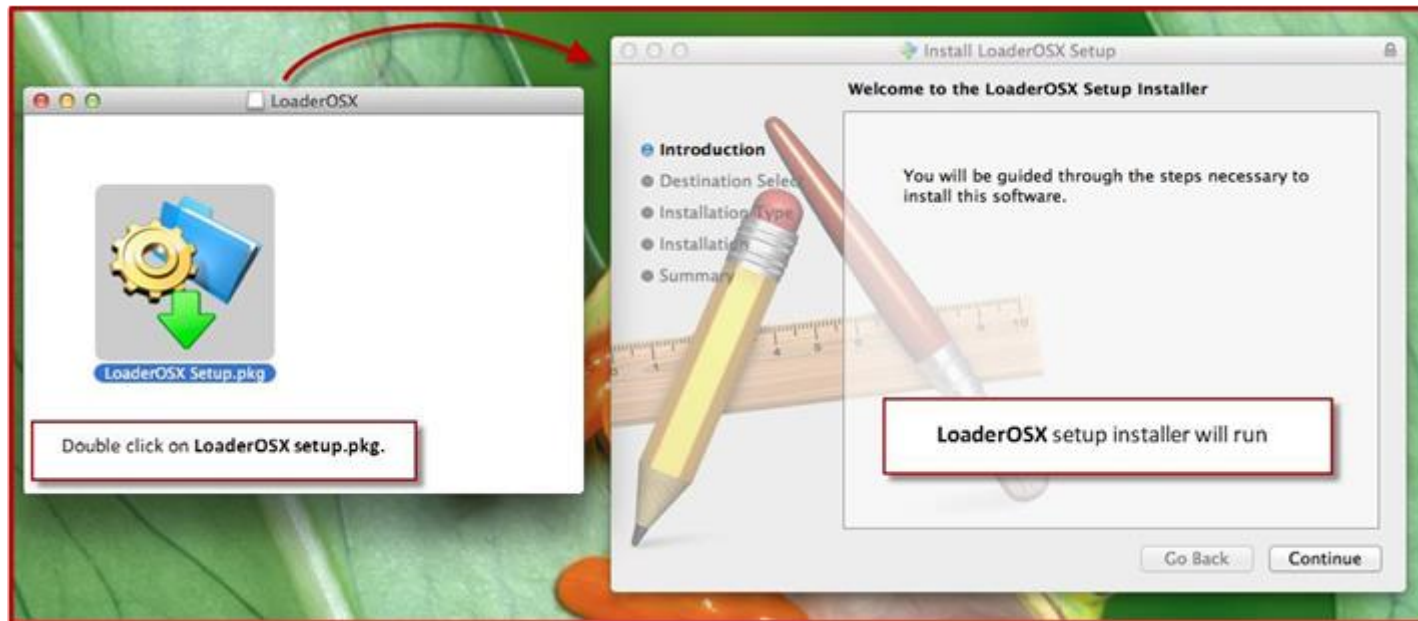

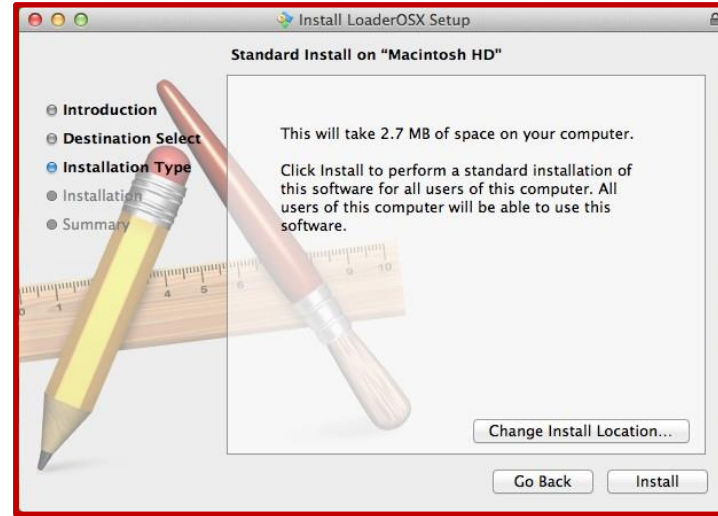
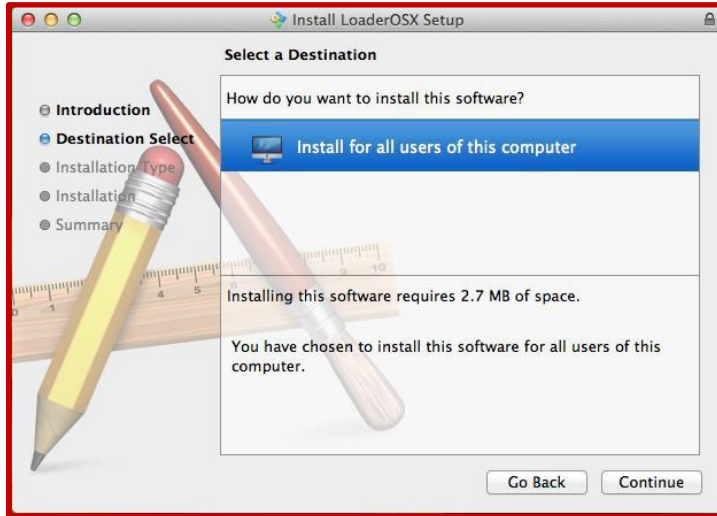
3. Double click the **LoaderOSX.dmg** from the downloads folder and LoaderOSX Setup.pkg windows will pop up. **LoaderOSX** installer will run after double clicking on **LoaderOSX setup.pkg**.

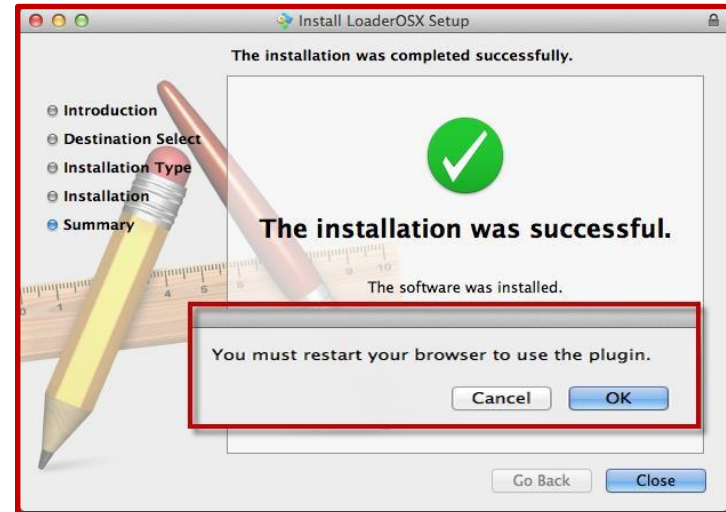
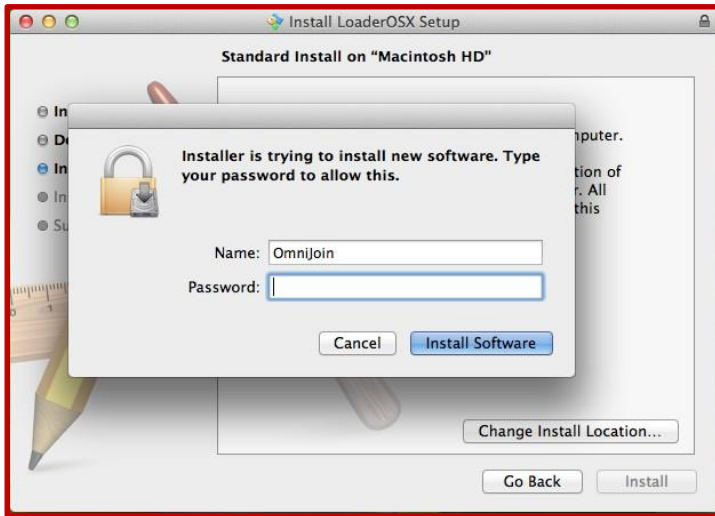
Mac – Link Method (continued)

4. Follow the prompt and continue through the installation.

5. LoaderOSX Setup will require you to enter your Mac user profile password to complete the installation



NOTE: YOU MUST RESTART YOUR BROWSER TO USE THE PLUGIN

6. After restarting the browser, copy and paste the OmniJoin Meeting URL to the address bar and then press "Enter". This will take you directly to OmniJoin Meeting room

NOTE: If you have "**Pop-up blocker**" enabled, please click on the "Pop-up blocker" notification button at the upper right hand corner of the browser window and select "**Always allow plugins on *.omnijoin.com**" or "**Run all plug-ins this time**". Once you have selected any of these options, you will be taken directly to your OmniJoin Meeting

Mac – Security Settings

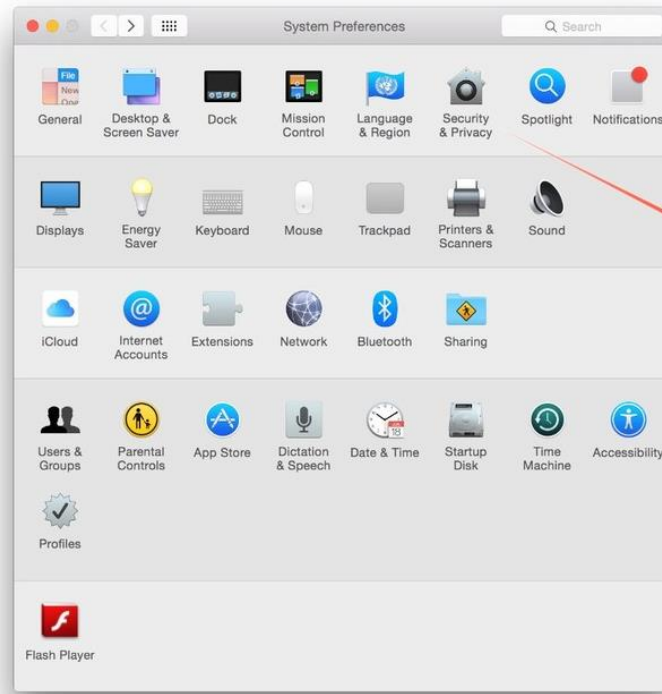
If you try to install or launch an application that is not permitted according to your Mac's security settings, you'll see an alert like this:



Mac – Security Settings

System Preferences controls system-wide settings such as Security and is available from the Apple menu at the upper-left corner of the screen

Within the System Preferences screen, double-click the Security & Privacy icon.

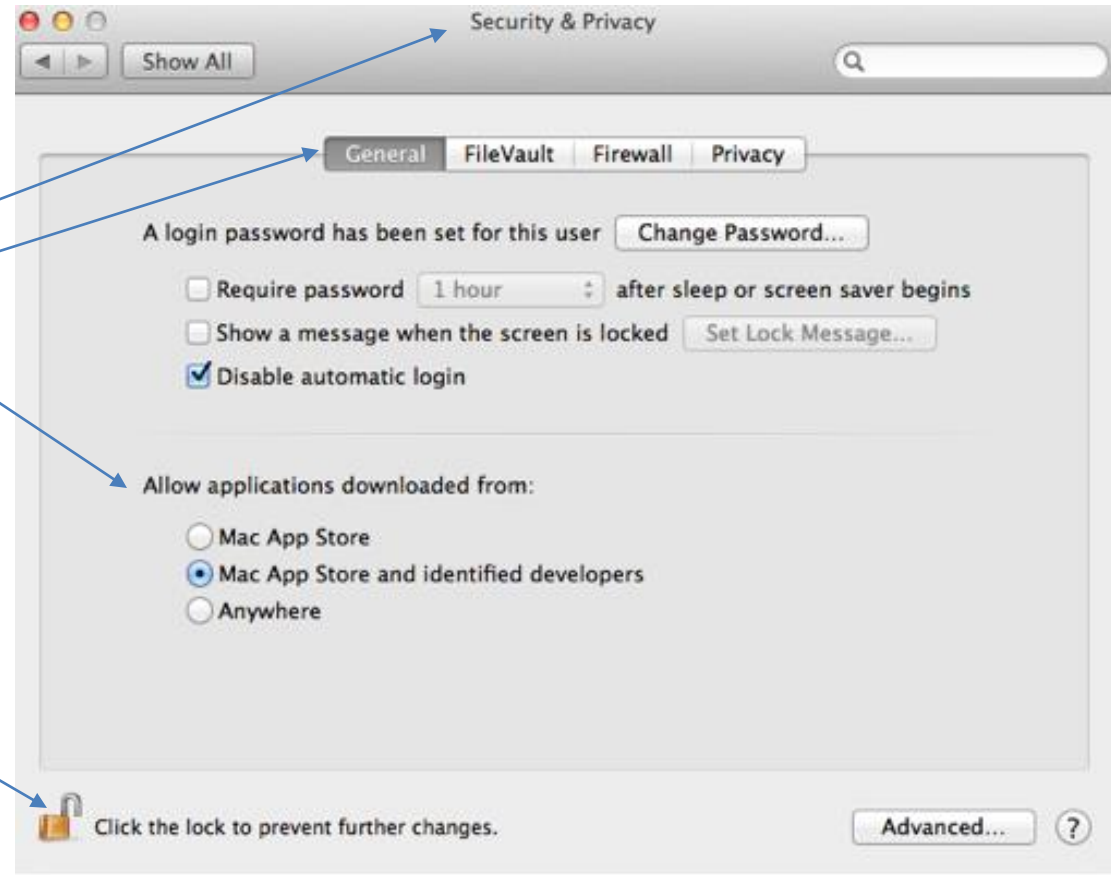


Mac – Security Settings

In the **Allow applications downloaded** from section of the Security & Privacy preferences'

General tab, you can choose the option you prefer:

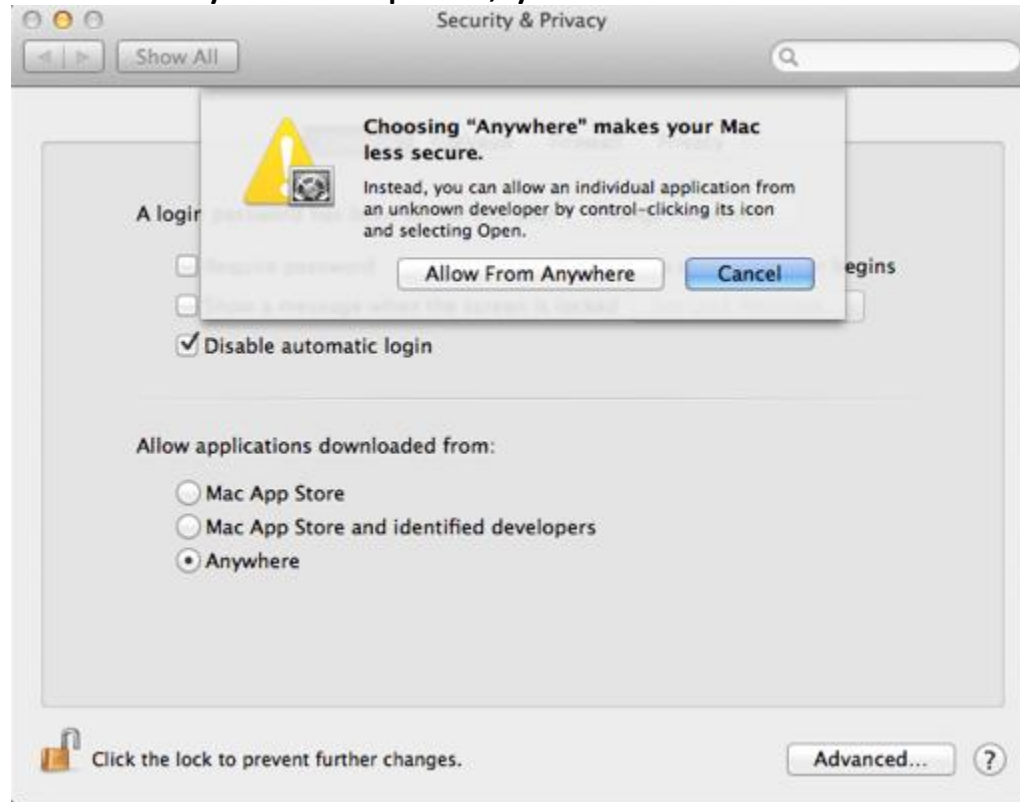
You will first need to click the lock and put in your Mac password to be able to change the settings here



- **Mac App Store:** check this to only allow applications from the Mac App Store to run.
 - **Mac App Store and identified developers:** choose this setting to be able to use applications from both the Mac App Store and those developers who have registered with Apple and have Developer IDs.
 - **Anywhere:** if you're not worried about the applications you install, and feel comfortable downloading and installing software from various web sites, then choose this setting.
- For OMNIJOIN you need to pick this last one.**

Mac – Security Settings

If you choose the Anywhere option, you'll see an alert:



Simply click "Allow From Anywhere" to confirm

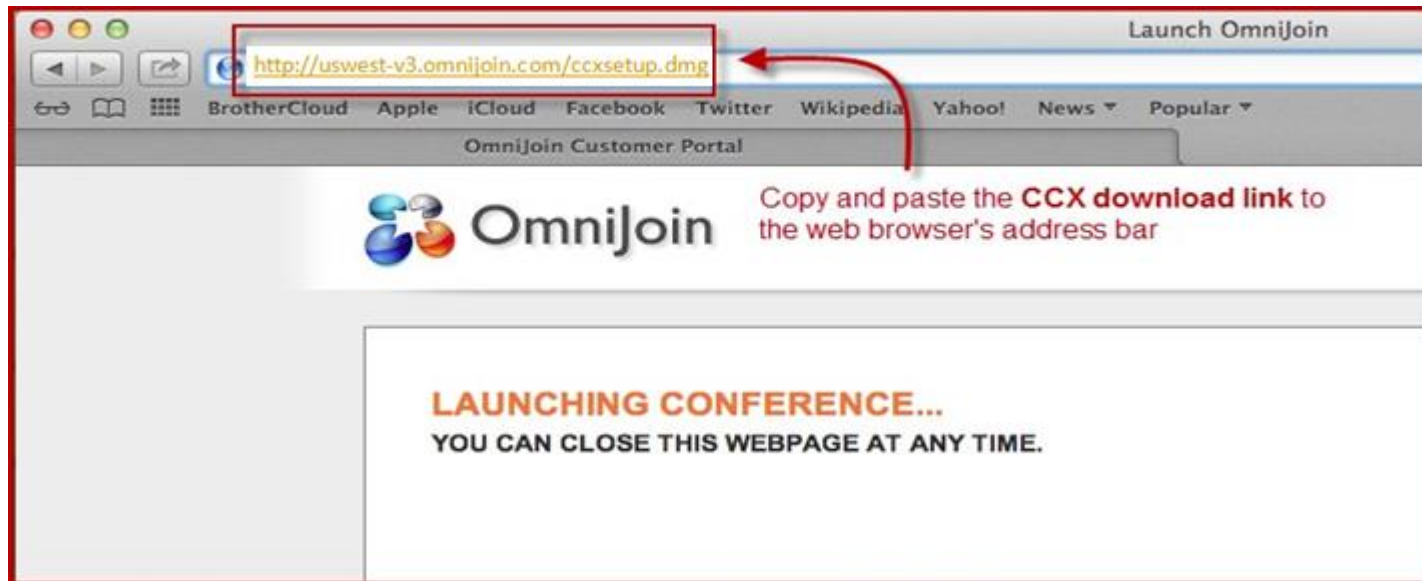
Mac – Conferencing Client Method

On some Macs, the link method will not work. In this case one needs to download and install a small applications (App) called the “Conferencing Client”

Here’s how:

1. Copy and paste the CCX download link to the web browser’s address bar.

2. CCXsetup.dmg file will be downloaded and saved to downloads folder.

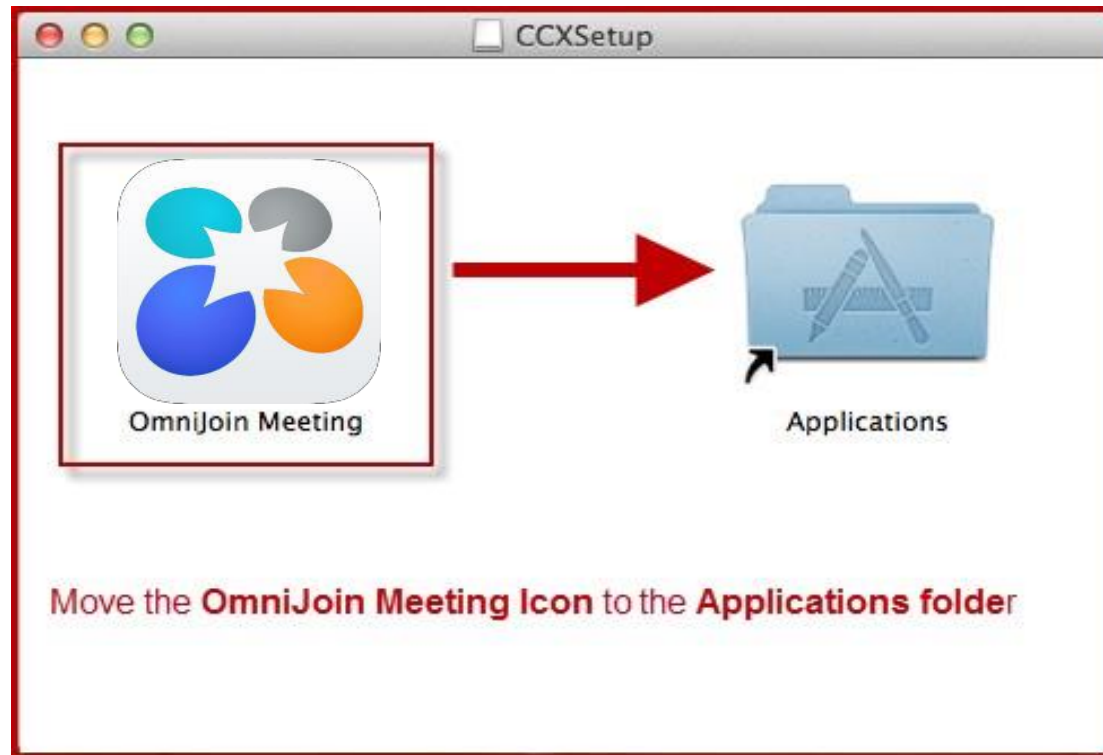

3. Double click the **ccxsetup.dmg** from the downloads folder and then MOVE (drag) the **OmniJoin Meeting Icon**



to the **Applications folder**.

4. You are now ready to join your class.

Go to **Applications** folder then double click the **OmiJoin icon**



and enter the meeting ID and password which you were given for your class.

Click “Join” and you will be brought into the online classroom.
